Hi,

Please see below for my responses to the 4 identified stakeholdee feedback questions, as well as a couple additional

- A. The split proposed is reasonable for the initial opening of the program, but should be revised in subsequent years if the program consistently goes into first come first served due to lack of projects being developed within the 70% category.
- B. Yes the prior year results for determining school Tier are sufficient.
- C. Our recommendation would be: 25% 250kW -50% 250kw to 1MW -25% >1MW

This is due to many schools having overall electric usage lower than a 1MW system will produce.

D. Allocations should follow the allocations in other ABP programs for the groups. Community solar projects at public schools should have a specific allocation to avoid all of the program funding being utilized by community solar projects.

Other comment

Public school projects already in the eaitlist should be offered the option to move the project into the public school program when final program details are available, but should not be forced into that program if it is not optimal for the project
