



REQUEST FOR STAKEHOLDER FEEDBACK

Publishing Community Solar Application Project Information from Projects Selected Through Waitlist Capacity Allocation Process

Under Section 1-75(c)(1)(G)(iv)(3) of the Illinois Power Agency Act (20 ILCS 3855), as modified through the Climate and Equitable Jobs Act (Public Act 102-0662), the first two blocks of annual capacity for traditional community solar projects participating in the Adjustable Block Program opened simultaneously on December 14, 2021, for a total capacity allocation of 250 MW. The IPA Act specifies that this block shall be filled with projects selected exclusively from waitlisted ABP community solar applications, with capacity allocated to Approved Vendors and their affiliates proportionate to those entities' shares of capacity of waitlisted applications. Approved Vendors had until March 14, 2022 to select which waitlisted projects they would apply to their allocated capacity, inclusive of any transfers of allocation from other Approved Vendors. The Illinois Power Agency is interested in feedback on the propriety of publishing project information for those community solar project applications submitted to the Agency for REC delivery contract approval on March 14, 2022, through this [waitlist capacity allocation process](#).

While the IPA generally does not disclose all project information publicly, limited project information—including Approved Vendor name, project application number, project name, project address, project size, and interconnection queue number (if available) —was released as part of the Agency's April 10, 2019 [lottery results](#). In light of recent inquiries around publishing information on the projects selected from the waitlist for this 250 MW of capacity and the potential value to Approved Vendors of understanding whether certain project selections may impact the viability of projects in another Approved Vendor's portfolio, the Agency seeks feedback on whether a similar disclosure process should be used for the portfolios of projects received by the March 14, 2022 submittal deadline.
