Program News

- Minimum Equity Standard (MES) Compliance Plans MES Compliance Plans were due June 1, 2023 and any plans that have not been submitted ARE OVERDUE. Failure to comply with this Program requirement may result in disciplinary action. The Program Administrator is currently working to score submitted plans. AVs and Designees can expect to be notified of their MES Score by the end of June. If you have not submitted your MES Compliance Plan, please contact the Program Administrator at admin@illinoisabp.com for assistance.
- Annual Reports AVs participating in Illinois Shines are required to submit an Annual Report pertaining to the contracts and systems in their portfolio. Annual Reports will open on July 1, 2023 and are due no later than July 17, 2023. Failure to submit an Annual Report is an Event of Default under the REC Contract and could impact an Approved Vendor's standing in the Program. To support Program participants, an Annual Report Guide has been published on the Program's website. An informational webinar was held Tuesday, May 9, 2023, and the recording and presentation slides have been uploaded to the Program Year Updates page.
- **New Program Year** The 2023-2024 Illinois Shines Program year began on June 1, 2023. A Program Year 2023-2024 Webinar was held May 25, 2023. The <u>recording</u>, <u>presentation slides</u>, <u>Q&A</u> are available at the Program website and provide links to the following resources.

- Long-Term Plan Update The Illinois Power Agency has issued two sets of requests for stakeholder feedback as the Agency prepares to develop its 2024 Long-Term Renewable Resources Procurement Plan. The linked information in the Stakeholder Feedback table provides due dates, background on the various feedback requests for stakeholder input, additionally the links provide details for how to submit responses. Stakeholders may respond to any of these subjects or submit feedback on any other topic related to the Agency's work. 
Ongoing Operations Updates

• **Part II Verification Cut Off for June -** To allow time for invoice calculation and generation, the last valid Part II verification date for June will be June 25, 2023. Applications that are Part II verified on or before June 25 will be on the July invoice. Application processing will continue throughout the last week of the month and any applications that are reviewed between June 26, 2023 and July 24, 2023 will be invoiced in August.



Application Processing Updates

- **Application Processing Tables** The Program Administrator updates the application processing tables at IllinoisABP.com/project-application-reports/ on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. On June 15, 2023, the Program Administrator published its newest Weekly Detail on Application Processing Progress announcement, including updated processing tables and staffing and portal improvements. - **Community-Driven Community Solar Application Review and Scoring Process** The Program Administrator has completed the application scoring period. Community-Driven Community Solar projects entered the scoring cure period on May 26, 2023. AVs, please check your SharePoint folders for more information regarding the curing of any *Need Info* requests related to project scores. Please respond promptly so the scoring cure process be completed on time. The Agency anticipates the next steps in this process with the following schedule in effect, pending prompt responses from AVs:
 - June 23, 2023 Release Scores, begin two-week appeal period
 - o July 7, 2023 Deadline for AVs to submit appeals to Program Administrator
 - o July 17, 2023 Appeals determinations released to Approved Vendors
 - July 26, 2023 Random selection event for tied scores (if necessary)
 - o July 29, 2023 Final scores published



The Community-Driven Community Solar application window for the 2023-2024 Program year closes August 30, 2023 (90 days after start of Program year). Please see Section 5 of the Program Guidebook for more information. Applications will not be accepted after close of the application window.

Updates on Portal Issues, Improvements, and Future Releases

The planned system maintenance windows on Tuesday and Thursday evenings (from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. CPT) will extend through June. During these maintenance windows, the Portal is expected to be unavailable to users, which the Program Administrator and Agency hope will be minimally disruptive to Program participants. Any users working in the portal should save their work prior to the 8:00 p.m. CPT start of the system maintenance window each day, as any unsaved information will be lost when the system is moved into maintenance mode. In the event that portal restoration is unexpectedly incomplete as of 10:00 p.m. CPT on a given evening, an update notice will be sent to AVs and Designees.

Capacity Management for 2023 Program Year Blocks	Capacity Management logic has been updated for the 2023 Program Year Blocks. Block limits are configurable by administrators within the portal. The portal will automatically close blocks once the maximum allocation is reached and start waitlisting projects. Application Processors can view live capacity data from the "Capacity Block" tab under Administration > Capacity Block Workbench.	June 1, 2023
API for Community Solar Disclosure Forms	An API has been released for AV and Designees who wish to build automated integrations between their systems and the IL Shines portal. This API is specific to Community Solar DFs and includes functionality to create a DF, retrieve status and calculated values from a DF or it's associated Project Application, retrieve a PDF copy of the DF for signature, and upload a signed PDF of the DF. Details of API functionality have been shared with members of the API Working Group. Any new AVs or Designees interested in developing their own integration between their applications and the IL Shines portal are encouraged to register for the API Working Group by completing the intake form (https://forms.office.com/r/ZsDHWsTaYH), and then emailing admin@illinoisabp.com to request API Access. Identified Application and Disclosure Form Issues - Launch Related	 A variety of project application, API, and Disclosure Form items have been remedied following June 1, 2023 Program year opening: Updated Character limits for Disclosure Form CSV upload process The character limits of five fields in the Disclosure Forms have been updated to match the portal versions of the forms. A corrected CSV Template for "Distributed Generation - Project Lease" button was updated to properly provide the template. The project application form was updated to ensure a required response only applicable to CDCS was corrected. Other project application field validation issues have been corrected, and additional data field validation and autopopulation issues are being addressed.
