

Designee Management Plans, Long-Term Plan Update, TCS Timeline for 2023-24 Projects

Program News

- **Designee Management Plans** Section X.B.1 of the Consumer Protection Handbook states that "[e]very Approved Vendor that works with or uses Designees is required to have and follow a Designee Management Plan as of September 1, 2023," and provides details on required plan components. The Program Administrator shared additional guidance on this requirement on <u>August 9, 2023</u>. With the **September 1, 2023**, deadline fast approaching, AVs are encouraged to reach out to the Program Administrator at <u>admin@IllinoisShines.com</u> with any questions in meeting this Program requirement.
- **Long-Term Plan Update** As previously <u>announced</u>, the IPA issued the first two sets of requests for stakeholder feedback on various chapters of the Long-Term Plan (see Stakeholder Feedback chart below for chapter details). The Agency anticipates the next steps in this process with the following schedule. Stakeholders should look out for the published draft Long-Term Plan and as a reminder, comments will be due to the Agency on September 29, 2023.
 - o Final Draft Release for stakeholder feedback August 15, 2023
 - Stakeholder comments due to IPA September 29, 2023
 - o Filing with ICC October 20, 2023
 - o ICC Order Expected February 19, 2024
- **Update on Certification of EEC AVs and Designees** As announced in the <u>July 21, 2023 announcement</u>, EEPs (Equity-Eligible Persons) that currently serve as the majority-owner of an EEC (Equity Eligible Contractor) AV may not submit additional requests to certify EEC AVs for which they serve as the majority-owner EEP, except for the case of Single-Project AVs. The IPA has received inquiries requesting if EEPs are permitted to register a company that is an EEC as both an AV and Designee. A single EEC may register as both an AV and a Designee within in the Program. An EEP may serve as the majority owner of an EEC AV that is also registered as a Designee, but may not serve as majority owner of a second company to register that company as an EEC Designee. To clarify further, an EEP may only serve as an EEP for one EEC-certified company.

The IPA has concluded that it does not further the objectives of the Equity Accountability System for an individual EEP to serve as the majority-owner for multiple Equity Eligible Contractors, whether these EECs are AVs or Designees. EEPs that currently serve as the majority-owner of an Equity Eligible Contractor AV or Designee may not submit additional requests to certify more than one company for which they are a majority owner as an EEC.

The IPA will incorporate this approach into the Draft Long-Term Plan being published for public comment on August 15, 2023, but will also apply it immediately, so as to avoid having to revoke any Equity Eligible Contractors certifications that may otherwise be approved before consideration of the issue by the ICC. Stakeholders are welcome to provide feedback through comments on the Draft Long-Term Plan.

- Traditional Community Solar (TCS) Timeline for Projects submitted June 1, 2023 The Agency anticipates 2023-2024 TCS project selection to follow the steps below, pending prompt responses from AVs. Projects submitted to Group A will be waitlisted and need to score a minimum 5 points to be added since there is 0 MW of capacity available. Projects submitted to Group B will be selected for capacity after November 2, 2022- May 31, 2023 scored projects. Capacity for Group B TCS will be 114.62 MW (unallocated capacity available upon the 2023-24 Program Year opening) minus the capacity of projects submitted to the Program between November 2, 2022- May 31, 2023.
 - o August 23, 2023 Release scores, begin two-week appeal period
 - o September 6, 2023 Deadline for AVs to submit appeals to Program Administrator



- September 18, 2023 Appeal determinations released to AVs and any changes to scores will be published on the website
- September 20, 2023 Random selection event for projects with tied scores
- September 22, 2023 Final scores published

- **Program Year 2023-2024 Community-Driven Community Solar (CDCS)** The CDCS application window for the 2023-2024 Program Year closes August 30, 2023 (90 days after start of Program Year). Please see Section 5 of the Program Guidebook for more information. Applications will not be accepted after close of the application window until the next Program Year. Waitlisted projects from the 2022-2023 Program Year will receive 2023-2024 capacity. After capacity is awarded to those projects, there will be 1.5 MW of capacity available for Group A (all 2023-24 projects will go on a waitlist if point minimum is reached) and 17.53 MW of capacity available for Group B projects submitted in the 2023-2024 Program Year. There was an error in the reported capacity from last week's announcement that has since been corrected. **The block capacity dashboard will be updated on the website to reflect these values.** The <u>August 4, 2023</u> announcement included reminders for a successful CDCS application submission.
- Part II Verification Cut Off for August To allow time for invoice calculation and generation, the last valid Part II Verification date for August will be August 25, 2023. Applications that are Part II verified on or before August 25, 2023 will be included in the September invoicing period. Application processing will continue throughout the last week of the month and any applications that are reviewed between August 26, 2023 and August 31, 2023 will be invoiced in October. For CS projects, due to additional invoice calculations that need to be done, the last valid Part II Verification date for August will be August 18, 2023.

- Mentorship Pilot Interest Form The Agency and Program Administrator will launch a Mentorship Pilot program in Fall 2023, with the goal of fostering relationships between market participants and empowering small businesses, Diverse Business Enterprises (DBEs), and Equity Eligible Contractors (EECs) with the tools and training to successfully participate in Illinois Shines. Entities interested in participating in the Mentorship Pilot are asked to complete a form available at https://forms.office.com/r/dMTyxVyLJi by September 1, 2023. There are a limited number of slots available for the first cohort of the Mentorship Pilot, and mentees will be selected on a first come, first serve basis.
- **DG DF API Working Group Call for Participation and Feedback -** The Agency and Program Administrator seek engagement from stakeholders regarding usage, functionality, and feedback on the development of a Distributed Generation (DG) Disclosure Form (DF) API (Application Program Interface) to be incorporated into the Program portal; a Community Solar DF API was recently added to the Program portal. - IPA Issues Request for AVs and Installer Designees Interested in Serving Stranded Illinois Shines DG Customers As previously announced, the Program continues to review submissions on a rolling basis for entities interested in serving stranded customers, with particular interest in identifying AVs and/or installer Designees willing to assist stranded customers with project maintenance/repair work. - **Re-Submitting Disclosure Forms** As a reminder, customers may not submit edits or re-submit DFs to the Program Administrator. AVs and Designees are asked to remind customers to direct DF questions to them. AVs and Designees must manage re-submissions of DFs to the Program portal.
