


Community-Driven Community Solar Applications, 2023-2024 TCS Timeline, Portal Roadmap Posted

September 1, 2023

Program News

Program Year 2023-2024 Community Driven Community Solar (CDCS) - August 30, 2023 concluded the 90-day project application window for CDCS applications as outlined in Section 5 of the Program Guidebook. A total of 63 applications were received during the application window, including 11 project applications totaling 25.70 MW AC for Group A, and 52 project applications totaling 64.95 MW AC for Group B. Applications for CDCS projects will not be accepted until the next Program Year (2024-2025). Waitlisted projects from the 2022-2023 Program Year will receive 2023-2024 capacity. After capacity is awarded to those projects, there will be 1.5 MW of capacity available for Group A (all 2023-24 projects will go on a waitlist if point minimum is reached) and 17.53 MW of capacity available for Group B projects submitted in the 2023-2024 Program Year.

The Program Administrator will start the initial review of project applications and continue to share updates as they move through the process of application review and scoring. Detailed information and expected timeline dates for the following stages will soon be shared and posted to the Program website's <u>CDCS Hub</u>.



- Traditional Community Solar (TCS) Timeline for Projects submitted June 1, 2023 As announced on August 24, 2023, all projects submitted in the 2022-2023 Program Year have been processed and scored. The anticipated schedule of next steps for applications submitted for the 2023-24 Program Year is the following:
 - September 8, 2023, 11:59 p.m. CPT Deadline for AVs to submit appeals to Program Administrator
 - September 18, 2023 Appeal determinations released to AVs and any changes to scores will be published on the website
 - September 20, 2023 Random selection event for projects with tied scores
 - o September 22, 2023 Final scores published
- Portal Development Roadmap A Portal Development Roadmap has been added to the Program website at the
 <u>Portal Updates & Help Guides page</u>. The Portal Development Roadmap is designed to preview upcoming,
 planned development for the Illinois Shines portal. Updates on the planned activities will be provided in weekly
 Program announcements, and detailed in the page's <u>Portal Updates Blog</u> in conjunction with software releases.
- Long-Term Plan Update As announced on <u>August 15, 2023</u>, the Agency has released the draft 2024 Long-Term Plan for public review and comment. The Agency anticipates the next steps in this process with the



following schedule. The IPA welcomes public comments on the draft 2024 Long-Term Plan. **Written comments** are due on Friday, September 29, 2023. The Agency will also hold virtual public hearings for the draft 2024 Long-Term Plan on September 15.

- Mentorship Pilot The Agency and Program Administrator will launch a Mentorship Pilot program in Fall 2023, with the goal of fostering relationships between market participants and empowering small businesses, Diverse Business Enterprises (DBEs), and Equity Eligible Contractors (EECs) with the tools and training to successfully participate in Illinois Shines. Participation for the first cohort of the Mentorship Pilot has been filled. Registration is now closed until the next mentorship cohort is announced. The Program Administrator will soon issue a survey to gauge interest from prospective mentors.
- Designee Management Plans Section X.B.1 of the Consumer Protection Handbook states that "[e]very Approved Vendor that works with or uses Designees is required to have and follow a Designee Management Plan as of September 1, 2023," and provides details on required plan components. The Program Administrator shared additional guidance on this requirement on <u>August 9, 2023</u>. The deadline for relevant AVs to create and maintain a Designee Management Plan is today, September 1, 2023. Please note: AVs need NOT submit these Plans unless requested by the Program Administrator.
- EEC Program News Recent Equity Eligibility Contractor (EEC) updates have included the following:
 - EEC Waitlists The EEC Group A and B waitlists have been published on the Program website's and are now available on the <u>Block Capacity Dashboard</u> page. Projects that exceed a given EEC's developer cap of 36.088 MW are indicated as such and are not eligible for capacity allocation until the 2024-2025 Program Year, regardless of whether additional capacity exists in the 2023-2024 Program Year.

- Consumer Education and Protection
 - Disclosure Forms (DFs) When New DFs are Needed, Signatory Requirement Exceptions, and Portal Inputs In the <u>August 25, 2023</u> announcement, the Program Administrator provided guidelines for <u>when new DFs are needed</u> and <u>DF signatory requirement exceptions</u>, and provided information regarding portal inputs including average retail rate (DG) and price to compare (CS).
 - O Distributed Generation (DG) Disclosure Form (DF) Application Programming Interface (API) Working Group Underway In support of the development of a DG DF API, entities who expressed interest in participating were sent a schedule survey on August 30, 2023 for a kickoff meeting to be held September 15 or September 18, 2023. Follow up meetings are initially anticipated for the weeks of September 25 and October 2, with additional information to follow. Participation is still welcomed by interested AVs and Designees.
 - Consumer Protection Working Group The Agency and the Program Administrators for the Illinois Shines and Illinois Solar for All programs hosted the September Consumer Protection Working Group meeting today, September 1, 2023. The presentation and notes from the Working Group will be published on the Program's website. The next Consumer Protection Working Group will be held on





Friday, October 6, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. CPT. If you are interested in participating in the group and future meetings, please <u>submit the form on the website</u>.

Ongoing Operations Updates

- August REC Invoicing Opens September 1, 2023 REC invoices and Quarterly Netting Statements will be made
 available for download from AV SharePoint folders on the morning of September 1, 2023. Invoices must be
 submitted to the utility by September 10, 2023 to receive payment for the September invoice period. Any
 invoice amounts not submitted to the utility by September 10, 2023 will be carried forward and included in the
 next invoice period (December 2023).
- Part II Verification Cut Off for September To allow time for invoice calculation and generation, the last valid
 Part II Verification date for September will be September 22, 2023. Applications that are Part II verified on or
 before September 22, 2023 will be included in the October invoicing period. Application processing will
 continue throughout the last week of the month and any applications that are reviewed between September
 23, 2023 and September 30, 2023 will be invoiced in November 2023.
- Re-Batching for ICC Meetings In advance of each submission of batches to the ICC for approval, AVs are provided the opportunity to review the projects that are about to be submitted for re-batching. During rebatching, AVs have the opportunity to withhold or re-batch projects. In the absence of any action by an AV, the Program Administrator will re-batch the projects at their discretion and submit eligible projects to the ICC.

It is extremely important that AVs review their re-batching files on SharePoint to indicate any re-batching preferences, but especially requests to withhold projects from submission. The Program Administrator alerts AVs by email when they have projects that are eligible for re-batching and planned to be submitted to the ICC in the next memo. Unfortunately, sometimes these communications are missed and projects are submitted to the ICC despite an AVs intent to hold a project back.

The Program Administrator requests that AVs who believe they may want to withhold or re-batch projects mark their calendars and review SharePoint folders for re-batching templates. This way, if any email alerts are missed, AVs are still aware of the dates that re-batching opens and can check if any projects are in the upcoming ICC submission. Below are re-batching windows for the rest of 2023:
