

# Long-Term Plan Comments Due Today, Group A Small DG Soft Close, Reminder: Cure Annual Report Deficiencies by October 13, 2023

- Stakeholder Feedback Opportunities
  - Long-Term Plan Update As announced on <u>August 15, 2023</u>, the Agency has released the draft 2024 Long-Term Plan for public review and comment. The IPA welcomes public comments on the draft 2024 Long-Term Plan. Written comments are due today, Friday, September 29, 2023. The Agency anticipates the next steps in this process with the following schedule:
    - August 15, 2023 Final Draft Release for stakeholder feedback
    - September 15, 2023 Virtual public hearings
    - September 29, 2023 Stakeholder comments due to IPA
    - October 20, 2023 Filing with ICC
    - February 19, 2024 ICC Order Expected
  - Approved Vendor Roundtables The Program Administrator sent out an email on September 22, 2023, to announce the next round of AV Roundtables for each project Category of the Illinois Shines program. These Roundtables follow the successful inaugural Roundtables held in Spring 2023 where AVs provided valuable perspectives to Illinois Shines. The Program Administrator requests that AVs complete the <u>survey</u> by today, September 29, 2023 by 11:59 p.m. CPT.
  - o Illinois Shines AV and Designee Satisfaction Survey Responses Requested by October 6, 2023 The survey link was shared on <u>September 22, 2023</u> and you can access the survey <u>here</u>.
- Distributed Generation Program News Recent Distributed Generation Program updates include the following:
  - Group A Small Distributed Generation Block Reaches Capacity, Soft Close Period Initiated As announced on September 26, 2023, the annual block of capacity for Group A Small Distributed Generation was reached and a soft close period was initiated, allowing the block to remain open for seven additional calendar days or until the submission of 10 additional megawatts, whichever comes first. The soft close period began on Tuesday, September 26, 2023, and will extend until October 3, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. CPT, or when 10 megawatts have been reached. Any applications batched and submitted to the Program under Group A Small DG block after the soft close capacity is reached OR after October 3, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. CPT will be placed on a waitlist. As a reminder an announcement on Group A DG capacity availability was distributed on September 6, 2023.
  - O Distributed Generation (DG) Disclosure Form (DF) Application Programming Interface (API) Working Group Underway A kickoff meeting was held September 18, 2023, which yielded valuable participation and feedback from participating entities. Further development based on the input provided at the meeting is underway, and the second meeting of the Working Group will be scheduled as soon as development proceeds. AVs and Designees interested in participating should email the Program Administrator at admin@IllinoisShines.com.
  - Reminder: Final Date to cure Annual Report Deficiencies is October 13, 2023 Under all versions of the REC Contract, the last day to cure Annual Report discrepancies is October 13, 2023. It is crucial that AVs respond to any requests to cure outstanding discrepancies by October 13, 2023 to ensure alignment between Program Administrator, AV, and Contracting Utility records as the finalized data will be used for various contract compliance items, including Three-Year Rolling Average Drawdown calculations. In the absence of



confirmation from AVs on these items, Program Administrator records will be used. No cures can be made beyond October 13, 2023 and the data will be considered final. The Program Administrator has distributed emails to AVs with discrepancies for the items listed below.

- Community Solar Program News Recent Community Solar Program updates include the following:
  - Program Year 2023-24 Community Driven Community Solar (CDCS) As shared on <u>September 1</u>, 2023, the Program Administrator has begun to review project applications and will continue to share updates as they move through the process of application review and scoring. Detailed information will soon be shared and posted to the Program website's <u>CDCS Hub</u>. The Agency anticipates 2023-2024 CDCS project selection to follow the steps below.
    - August 31, 2023 September 22, 2023 Application Review (approximately 3 weeks)
    - September 23, 2023 October 6, 2023 Application Cure Period (approximately 2 weeks)
    - October 7, 2023 October 27, 2023 Application Scoring Period (approximately 3 weeks)
    - October 28, 2023 November 10, 2023 Application Scoring Cure Period (approx. 2 weeks)
    - November 15, 2023 Release scores, begin two-week appeal period
    - December 1, 2023 Deadline for AVs to submit appeals to Program Administrator
    - December 15, 2023 Appeal determinations released to AVs and any changes to scores will be published on the website
    - December 20, 2023 Random selection event for projects with tied scores (if necessary)
    - December 22, 2023 Final Scores published

## Ongoing Operations Updates

October REC Invoicing Opens October 1, 2023 - REC invoices and Quarterly Netting Statements will be made
available for download from AV SharePoint folders on the morning of October 1, 2023. Invoices must be
submitted to the utility by October 10, 2023 to receive payment for the October invoice period. Any invoice





amounts not submitted to the utility by October 10, 2023 will be carried forward and included in the next invoice period (January 2023).

- Part II Verification Cut Off for October To allow time for invoice calculation and generation, the last valid Part II Verification date for October will be October 24, 2023. Applications that are Part II verified on or before October 24, 2023 will be included in the November invoicing period. Application processing will continue throughout the last week of the month and any applications that are reviewed between October 25, 2023 and October 31, 2023 will be invoiced in December 2023.
- Re-Batching for ICC Meetings In advance of each submission of batches to the ICC for approval, AVs are provided the opportunity to review the projects that are about to be submitted for re-batching. During rebatching, AVs have the opportunity to withhold or re-batch projects. In the absence of any action by an AV, the Program Administrator will re-batch the projects at their discretion and submit eligible projects to the ICC.

It is extremely important that AVs review their re-batching files on SharePoint to indicate any re-batching preferences, but especially requests to withhold projects from submission. The Program Administrator alerts AVs by email when they have projects that are eligible for re-batching and planned to be submitted to the ICC in the next memo. Unfortunately, sometimes these communications are missed and projects are submitted to the ICC despite an AVs intent to hold a project back.

The Program Administrator requests that AVs who believe they may want to withhold or re-batch projects mark their calendars and review SharePoint folders for re-batching templates. This way, if any email alerts are missed, AVs are still aware of the dates that re-batching opens and can check if any projects are in the upcoming ICC submission. #### **Application Processing Updates**

- Application Processing Tables Application processing tables are maintained at <u>IllinoisShines.com/project-application-reports/</u>. Effective the week of September 18 these tables are now updated daily. For questions about specific project applications, please contact the Program Administrator at <u>admin@IllinoisShines.com</u>.
- **Application Tips and Tricks** Supplementing previous guidance, the Program Administrator seeks to continue supporting stakeholders in the avoidance of project applications entering *Need Info* status.
  - Required Meter Photo There is frequently confusion around the required meter photo. Stakeholders should keep the following in mind when submitting application documentation:
    - When the inverter and meter are two different pieces of equipment, a photograph of the solar dedicated meter (NOT the utility meter) is required.



- The photograph must clearly show current cumulative lifetime meter reading or, if the meter does not a physical display, a screenshot of the monitoring portal with the lifetime meter reading is acceptable.
- If a screenshot is used, it must be from the meter portal and not the inverter portal.
- The cumulative lifetime meter reading must be greater than zero.

- Updates on Portal Issues, Improvements, and Future Releases The planned system maintenance windows on Tuesday and Thursday evenings (from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. CPT) will extend through October. During these maintenance windows, the Portal is expected to be unavailable to users, which the Program Administrator and Agency hope will be minimally disruptive to Program participants. Any users working in the portal should save their work prior to the 8:00 p.m. CPT start of the system maintenance window each day, as any unsaved information will be lost when the system is moved into maintenance mode. In the event that portal restoration is unexpectedly incomplete as of 10:00 p.m. CPT on a given evening, an update notice will be sent to AVs and Designees. On October 12, 2023 the maintenance window will extend through 6:00 a.m. CPT on October 13, 2023 to accommodate additional releases.

DG Purchase Disclosure Form – Question 87 and 86	When creating Disclosure Forms, if "no" is entered for question 86: "Is the installation contract contingent upon the selection for the Adjustable Block Program incentive?", then question 87: "Will the pricing terms change if the project is not selected for the Adjustable Block Program incentive?" is not be required to be answered. Prior to this fix, the portal was returning an error in the CSV upload process requiring question 87 even when the answer to question 86 was "no". The CSV upload process will now only require question 87 to be answered when question 86 is answered with a value other than "no".	September 29, 2023		
Customer Email Requirements	Customer/subscriber email addresses on CS and DG Disclosure Forms is no longer required by the portal form, CSV upload, or API.	September 29, 2023
