Working Groups and AV Roundtables

Forums are hosted by the Program Administrator on topics for Approved Vendor input and further discussion.

- Consumer Protection Working Group
 - Occurs monthly to discuss market trends, best practices, consumer education, updates to Program requirements and documents and other consumer protection issues for both Illinois Shines and Illinois Solar for All
- Disclosure Form Application Programming Interface (API) Working
 Group
 - Previous groups formed for the CS and DG Disclosure Form API development, to gain Approved Vendors and Designee input, understand usage, develop requirements, and provide support
- AV Roundtables
 - The Program Administrator has held two rounds of AV Roundtables, designed to solicit sector-specific input, feedback, and dialog to understand opportunities for the Program to better support participating entities

Building Our Solar Future


Brand Refresh:
