- **Application Tips and Tricks** - The Program Administrator publishes [Tips and Tricks](#) to help support stakeholders in avoiding project applications from resulting in a *Need Info* request and delaying their review and approval.
 - **Battery Backup:** As energy storage becomes increasingly more common as an add-on to solar projects, it is important to understand how to successfully note battery backup components in the application.
 - Part II Section 4 of the application “Equipment Details” includes a battery prompt ‘**Does your system have a battery backup?**’ with a dropdown menu allowing a “Yes” or “No” selection.
 - If the system does include a battery backup, please answer "Yes" and ensure that the battery schematic document has been uploaded as a Part II Document.
 - Indicating that a battery backup exists but not including a schematic will result in a Need Info request that will delay application review.
 - If the system does not include a battery backup, please answer "No." No additional schematics are expected to be uploaded with the project documentation for systems that do not include a battery backup.

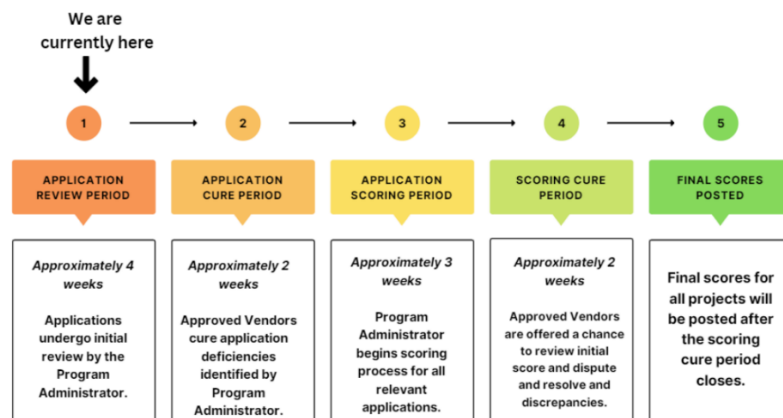

- **Illinois Power Agency Launches Dedicated Small and Emerging Business Hub** - On [September 26, 2024](#) the IPA [announced](#) the launch of a dedicated [Small and Emerging Business Hub](#), with a goal to centralize industry-specific information to help small and emerging businesses connect with targeted programs and resources that meet their needs in entering the clean energy economy. The Hub, which resides on the [Energy Workforce Equity Portal](#), streamlines new and existing resources to small and emerging businesses navigating the solar landscape in Illinois. The announcement provides details on the Hub including resources available to AVs and Designees, the concept for the Hub, and highlights key features of the Hub.

 - **Results of Program Year 2024-25 Traditional Community Solar (TCS) Random Selection Event** - The TCS Random Selection was held on September 10, 2024. Resources from the event have been posted to the Program's [Traditional Community Solar](#) page. Project waitlists have been updated on the [Block Capacity Dashboard](#) page.
 - **Community-Driven Community Solar Update** - The application submission deadline for Program Year 2024-25 CDCS projects was September 3, 2024. Applications are not accepted after the close of the application window. **Please see the proposed schedule below for application review and scoring:**
 - Application Review Period - Applications undergo initial review by Program Administrator
 - Application Cure Period - AVs cure deficiencies identified by Program Administrator
 - Application Scoring Period - Program Administrator begins scoring process for all relevant applications (those submitted without deficiencies and those that successfully cure deficiencies during the 2-week cure period)
 - Scoring Cure Period - AVs are offered a chance to review initial score and dispute and resolve any discrepancies



- **Request for Stakeholder Feedback on Consumer Protection Initiatives – Due October 7, 2024** - On [September 16, 2024](#), the Program requested stakeholder feedback on detailed proposals for three new Consumer Protection initiatives: an [escrow process](#), a [stranded customer REC adder](#), and a [Restitution Program](#). A framework for each of these initiatives was approved as part of the 2024 Long-Term Plan, and the Agency is now seeking feedback on more comprehensive proposals for each initiative. Ongoing Operations Updates

- **Re-Batching for ICC Meetings** – Due to an increase in late requests to withhold projects from submission to the ICC, the Program Administrator would like to remind AVs of the important information below.

In advance of each submission of batches to the ICC for approval, AVs are provided the opportunity to withhold or re-batch projects. [AVs must indicate any requests to withdraw or withhold projects during the two-day re-batching window.](#) In the absence of any action by an AV, the Program Administrator will re-batch the projects at their discretion and submit eligible projects to the ICC.

- [It is extremely important that AVs review their re-batching files on SharePoint to indicate any re-batching preferences, but especially requests to withhold projects from submission.](#) The Program Administrator alerts AVs by email when they have projects that are eligible for re-batching and planned to be submitted to the ICC in the next memo. Unfortunately, sometimes these communications are missed, and projects are submitted to the ICC despite an AVs intent to hold a project back.
- The Program Administrator requests that AVs who believe they may want to withhold or re-batch projects mark their calendars and review SharePoint folders for re-batching templates. This way, if any email alerts are missed, AVs are still aware of the dates that re-batching opens and can check if any projects are in the upcoming ICC submission. Below are the next re-batching windows:

- **October REC Invoicing Opens October 1, 2024** - REC invoices and Quarterly Netting Statements will be made available for download from AV SharePoint folders on **October 1, 2024**. Invoices must be submitted to the utility by **October 10, 2024** to receive payment for the November invoice period. Any invoice amounts not submitted to the utility by October 10, 2024 will be carried forward and included in the next invoice period (January 2024).
- **Part II Verification Cut Off for October** - To allow time for invoice calculation and generation, the last valid Part II Verification date for October will be **October 23, 2024**. Applications that are Part II verified on or before October 23, 2024 will be included in the November invoicing period. Application processing will continue throughout the last week of the month and any applications that are reviewed between October 24, 2024 and October 31, 2024 will be invoiced in December 2024.

Application Processing Updates

- **Application Processing Update** - The Program Administrator has completed the review of all Small DG waitlisted applications and is currently reviewing applications from the 2024-25 Program Year across all project categories. The Program Administrator expects to be within a two-week turnaround time for review of

applications submitted in the 2024–25 Program Year at the end of September for all application categories. This forecast is subject to change, and updates will be provided in each weekly announcement until processing times are back within a normal range.

- Portal Maintenance and Releases** - Scheduled system maintenance windows will continue on **Tuesday and Thursday evenings (from 8:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. CPT)**, during which times the Portal is typically unavailable to users; the Program hopes these windows are minimally disruptive to Program participants. **Users working in the Portal should save their work prior to the 8:00 p.m. CPT start of system maintenance window, as any unsaved information will be lost when the system is moved into maintenance mode.** In some cases, Portal availability may resume earlier than noted, though **AVs and Designees should plan on the full three hours.**

- Annual Report Cure Period Continues** - The Annual Report cure period is in progress. The Program Administrator is reviewing responses to discrepancies identified during the Annual Reporting period and has emailed affected AVs to resolve outstanding items. All discrepancies must be resolved by **October 15, 2024**. Failure to cure discrepancies may be a Program violation. AVs must be responsive to requests for information.
- MES 2023-24 Year End Report Next Steps** - The Program is reviewing all submitted Minimum Equity Standard (“MES”) Year-End Reports. Participating entities will be notified of their MES Rating beginning in September. Notice of Potential Violations (“NoPVs”) were sent out on September 10, 2024 to entities that failed to submit. The Agency encourages non-compliant entities to respond and get into compliance.
- Updates to Disclosure Form Deep Dives** - The Program has added information regarding upcoming net metering changes on the [Disclosure Form Deep Dives](#), including supply-only net metering, which will be applicable for customers approved for net metering after January 1, 2025.
