 - In Section 3 of the Part II application, AVs must now use the full docket number for the question, "ICC Docket Number for the Certification of the DG Installer Record." instead of a free-form field.
 - ICC Docket numbers must be entered in the following format is PXXXX-XXXX. Using an incorrect format will prevent saving.

- 2025 REC Price Survey Released The last day to submit responses to the 2025 REC Pricing Model Cost Input survey is today, January 24, 2025. This survey supports the Agency in collecting Illinois-specific project cost data for use in improving the modeling used to set REC prices for the upcoming 2025-26 Program Year. Ongoing Operations Updates

• Re-Batching for ICC Meetings – Due to an increase in late requests to withhold projects from submission to the ICC, the Program Administrator would like to remind AVs of the important information below.

In advance of each submission of batches to the ICC for approval, AVs are provided the opportunity to withhold or re-batch projects. AVs must indicate any requests to withdraw or withhold projects during the two-day re-batching window. In the absence of any action by an AV, the Program Administrator will re-batch the projects at their discretion and submit eligible projects to the ICC.

- o It is extremely important that AVs review their re-batching files on SharePoint to indicate any re-batching preferences, but especially requests to withhold projects from submission. The Program Administrator alerts AVs by email when they have projects that are eligible for re-batching and planned to be submitted to the ICC in the next memo. Unfortunately, sometimes these communications are missed, and projects are submitted to the ICC despite an AVs intent to hold a project back.
- The Program Administrator requests that AVs who believe they may want to withhold or re-batch projects mark their calendars and review SharePoint folders for re-batching templates. This way, if any email alerts are missed, AVs are still aware of the dates that re-batching opens and can check if any projects are in the upcoming ICC submission. Below are the next re-batching windows:

• Part II Verification Cut Off for January - To allow time for invoice calculation and generation, the last valid Part II Verification date for January will be January 27, 2025. Applications that are Part II verified on or before January 27, 2025 will be included in the January invoicing period. Application processing will continue throughout the last week of the month and any applications that are reviewed between January 28, 2025 and January 31, 2025 will be invoiced in March 2025.

- Portal Maintenance and Releases Scheduled system maintenance windows will continue on Tuesday and Thursday evenings (from 8:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. CPT), during which times the Portal is typically unavailable to users; the Program hopes these windows are minimally disruptive to Program participants. Users working in the Portal should save their work prior to the 8:00 p.m. CPT start of system maintenance window, as any unsaved information will be lost when the system is moved into maintenance mode. In some cases, Portal availability may resume earlier than noted, though AVs and Designees should plan on the full three hours.

Net Metering: DG Disclosure Form - "What is the customer's expected annual electricity usage in kWh?" question seems to blank out/not be saving when users resume an unsubmitted form.	When resuming an existing unsubmitted Disclosure Form, the "What is the customer's expected annual electricity usage in kWh?" question would occasionally blank out as the editable form page loaded depending on answers in other fields. This was because the field was originally planned to be conditionally required based on the "Customer type" answer, but that was changed in an early prototype as it was identified that the information would still be applicable/useful on all projects. The bug has been corrected and the "What is the customer's expected annual electricity usage in kWh?" field will no longer blank out when resuming an unsubmitted Disclosure Form for editing. Spanish DG Disclosure Forms - Dropdown and static text in data fields translations	When Spanish Disclosure Forms are generated for Purchase, Lease or PPA, any data values that are dropdown values that show in English, will now show in Spanish on the PDF of the Disclosure Form. The list of translations in PDF of Disclosure Forms will include options where the dropdown values are: 1) Yes/No 2) Approved Vendor, Vendor/Designee, Lessor, Installer, Seller, Customer 3) Roof-mounted, Ground-mounted 4) Residential/Small Commercial, Large Commercial/Industrial, Public Schools	January 22, 2025
Added field validation for ICC Docket Number (Part II application)	The Program added validation to ICC Docket Number field in Part II, Section 3 requiring the value to be formatted as PXXXX-XXXX. AVs will not be able to save the section with invalid entries.	January 22, 2025
Updated "Copy Disclosure Form" function to include new fields	The "Copy Disclosure Form" function has been updated to include certain fields that were previously excluded (including but not limited to potential installers and fees) and exclude others that were incorrectly included.	January 22, 2025
Project Application Dashboard Improvements	Seven fields have been added as new filters to AVs' Project Applications Dashboards. Column headers in AVs' Project Application Dashboards referencing "Part 1"/"Part 2" have been renamed to display in Roman numerals ("Part I"/"Part II") to align with proper Program nomenclature. The seven fields are: - Assigned Block - Part I Submission Date - Part I Submission Date - Part I Verification Date - Part I Need Info Date - Part I Need Info Date	January 22, 2025
